## ABOUT THE GAMES

### The Westfield Health British Transplant Games are a celebration of life.

The Games are organised on behalf of Transplant Sport whose aim is to raise awareness of the need for organ donation, encourage transplant recipients to lead active lifestyles and show appreciation for, and remember, donors and their families. The Games also increase awareness of Anthony Nolan and their need for blood stem cells and bone marrow donation.

The four day event attracts some 2500 registered participants, including 1000 transplanted athletes, 150 living donor athletes, donor families, and supporters.

Transplant athletes range from three to eighty years of age, in what is a huge, inclusive festival of sports participation, fun and competition, involving 24 sports.





We offer a range of partnership options and we would welcome the opportunity to speak with you and work up an appropriate package against the level of support your organisation is able to provide. This event will attract significant media exposure which will benefit both the charities and our partners.

If cash or sponsorship is not possible, we can consider value-in-kind support, volunteering and secondments, plus promotion of the Games through your media channels.

You can participate in the Games by entering the annual Donor Run (5km/3km) as a group, or individually, where you can run/jog/walk to support the Games.
